- ❖ Certificate course in Physical Education (C.P.Ed.) of the Government Maharashtra or other equivalent Examination in Physical Education recognised by the R.T.M. Nagpur University.
- ❖ Proficiency in games and sports, preference will be given to those candidates who have represented school, college or state in any game or sports.

AGE LIMIT

- ❖ The applicant who has attained or shall attain the age of 17 years on the 1st October of the year of his/her admission to the course is eligible for admission of first B.P.E.

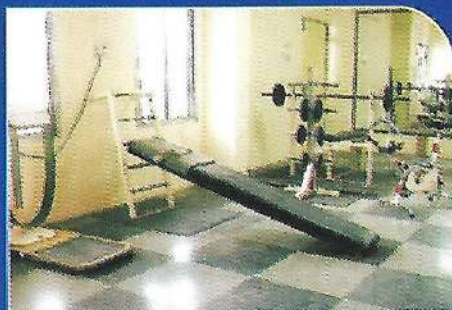
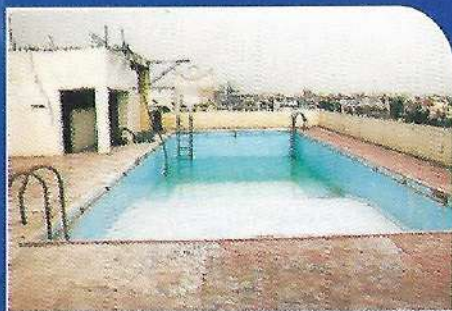

Duration of the Course

One Academic Session of About 10 months form July to April.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicant should have passed B.A. or B.Com., Or B.Sc. Degree (10+2+3) pattern of R.T.M. Nagpur University or any University incorporated by law in India with any language passing.

Graduates other than R.T.M. Nagpur University are eligible for admission to B.P.Ed. only if their Degrees are acceptable and recognized by R.T.M. Nagpur University.

Proficiency in games and sports:- Candidate who has represented his/he School/College? State team in any recognized game will be given preference in admission.

AGE

Applicant must have completed the age of 19 years on or before the date of submitting application for admission to the Examination. Applicants above the age of 35 years will also be admitted provided they are permitted by R.T.M. Nagpur University and are completely Physically fit to under go the training and submit the Physical fitness certificate from a competent Medical or Health authority.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- ❖ Any other qualification claimed by candidate equivalent to the above will be considered only on condition that he/she gets the clearance from R. T.M. Nagpur
- ❖ After scrutiny of applications, Degrees and other Certificates will be called for Physical efficiency test and personal interview.
- ❖ Only those candidates who have passed the physical efficiency test and interview satisfactorily will be considered for selection and they will be admitted provisionally according to the merit. Their admission will be confirmed subject to the verification of qualifying degrees and clearance from the R.T.M. Nagpur University.

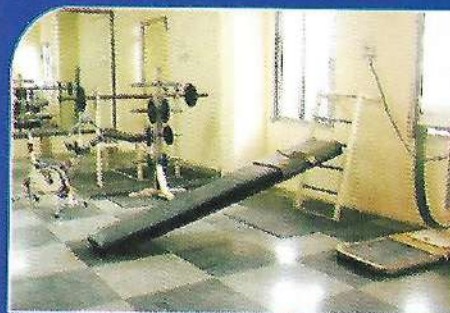

PASSING THE EXAMINATION

In order to pass the examination an examinee must obtain (1) (A) Not less than 40% marks including internal assessment in each theory paper and (B) 45% of the aggregate marks in all the theory papers (2) not less than 50% marks including internal assessment separately in (a) part-II skills and (b) Part-III Practice Teaching.

Division

Successful examinees obtaining the following percentage of marks in the aggregate of the examination as a whole i.e., Theory, Skills and Practice Teaching shall be placed in Division as under:-

First Division	:	65% and above
Second Division	:	55% to 64%
Third Division	:	All other successful candidate will be placed in Third Division.

DISTINCTION

Successful Examinees obtaining not less than 75% marks in Part-I Theory shall be declared to have passed the examination with distinction in theory and those obtaining not less than 80% of the total marks in Part-II shall be declared to have passed the examination with distinction in that part.

NOTE

B.P.Ed. Course each paper will be of 90 marks respectively and 10 marks respectively of each paper are for the assignment and written tests to be internally assessed.

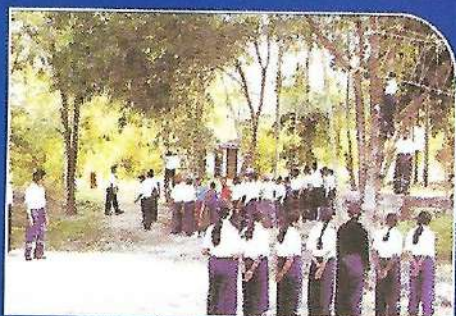
4. LAST DATE FOR ADMISSION

- ❖ Ordinarily the last date for admission to B.P.Ed. (One Year) course is 15th June.
- ❖ There are limited seats and generally the admission are full by the last week of June.
- ❖ Application duly filled in should be sent to be Principal, **Padmashri Ajit Wadekar Sharirik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya** with registration fee of Rs.250/- by money Order / Postal Order.

DATE OF OPENING

Generally the regular Practical Theory classes of B.P.E. and B.P.Ed. (One Year) courses starts from 15th July month every year or as decided by the college authorities.





PAYMENT OF FEES

Merely sending the Admission form and registration fees does not entitle a candidate to the admission to the course in the college. Only those candidates who pass the Physical efficiency test and interview satisfactorily will be considered for selection.

Admission shall be confirmed only after the payment of total and other charges within five days from the declaration of the selection list, failing which the candidate concerned will not be admitted to the College and a candidate in the waiting list will be given preference for admission in his/her place. Those who fall under E.B.C. Category as per the Rules of Govt. of Maharashtra will pay all fees tuition fees.

Except deposits all fees are non refundable.

NOTE

- i) Fees will not be accepted in instalments.
- ii) Others Fees, include Camp Fee, Uniform Fee, Track Suit Charges.

E.B.C. CONCESSION AND FREE STUDENTS

Students from Maharashtra are generally entitled for concession in fees under E.B.C.P.T.C. & Freedom Fighter concession schemes as per Govt. of Maharashtra Rule G.O.I. Scholarship is also available to the backward class students of Maharashtra as well as students outside Maharashtra.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

WORKING HOURS: Daily working hours will be adjusted according to the climatic conditions, seasons and convenience.

ATTENDANCE

90% attendance at the classes is required in the order of quality for the University Examination. Students short of required attendance will be liable to be debarred from appearing at the University Examination, fine will be imposed for non-attendance at the classes without prior permission as per the University Rules, for the first 6 days and for next 9 days fine will be levied at the rate of Rs.2/- per day. After this the name of the defaulting student will be struck off from the roll of the college.

CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

Utmost importance is given to the maintenance of discipline during the period of training, punctuality, regularity, hard work and good behaviour are absolutely essential for completion of training.

Any objectionable conduct reported or observe within or outside the premises of the Institution will make any student (men or women) liable for strict disciplinary action.

HEALTH

The training at the College involves great deal of physical actives and strenuous work and only those who have robust constitution, sound health and healthy.





UNIFORM
